II. Project Information

7. Project Goal:

To provide long-term comprehensive health assistance to the people in the province of Pisco (pop: 125,000), specifically in the district of San Clemente (pop: 30,000).

8. Project Objectives:

- 1 – *Treatment of acute and chronic illnesses in the urgent care center “Policlínico Peruano Americano.” San Clemente is a very impoverished area and all services are offered free of charge. Much attention is given towards prevention and health education within all facets of the clinic’s operation.*
- 2 – *To improve the comprehensive health of the community through outreach programs, educational programs, and public health initiatives*

9. Summary of RMF-sponsored activities carried out during the reporting period under each project objective (note any changes from original plans):

BACKGROUND

On August 15, 2007, Pisco, Peru experienced a deadly earthquake...7.9 on the Richter Scale. Over 1,000 people died, 40,000 families left without homes, 150,000 people left without water. The majority of the health infrastructure was damaged or destroyed in the earthquake and the people are in need of medical attention. The Real Medicine Foundation team was deployed to Peru on October 12 in an effort to assist those in need. The primary Objective of the project is to bring long-term free healthcare to the victims of the earthquake who have lost their homes, possessions, and in many cases, loved ones. The areas most affected were Pisco, Ica, Chincha, Cañete, and Huancavelica. The site of the RMF clinic is in the San Clemente, Pisco. San Clemente is the poorest district of Pisco and the overwhelming majority cannot afford paid health services. In addition, outreach programs are being initiated to service the health needs in the very remote and impoverished areas around Pisco.

San Clemente is a very impoverished area and all of the services offered are free. The clinic places much importance on prevention and education and this is evident within all facets of the clinic operations.

The Policlínico Peruano Americano opened its doors on December 10, 2007 on Calle Santa Lucia N° 102 del Sector Agua Santa en San Clemente.

10. Results and/or accomplishments achieved during this reporting period:

- On April 27th, we met with the owners of the clinical laboratory “Milagritos,” one of the most reputable in the province. We have the possibility of working with them, where the tests will be taken in the Policlínico. The prices are reasonable and with exonerations for patients in financial need.
- The Internal Procedures Manual was elaborated.
- The Civil Defense certificate exonerating us of the payment was obtained.
- The Municipal License was obtained S/. 125,00 (including the discount)
- The agreement was signed for gathering of the “Red Bags” medical waste collection service
- We presented the Ministry of Health with the file containing all the documents we’ve being asked for, for fulfillment of MoH requirements
- The contracts signed by the clinic staff were submitted to the Ministry of Work, each inscription for S/.34.00
- In this month, a total of S/.1301.00 was collected for consultations and we have exonerated 38 patients
- A new account for RMFP at SCOTIABANK was opened.
- Three wood benches were fixed for S/.45.00

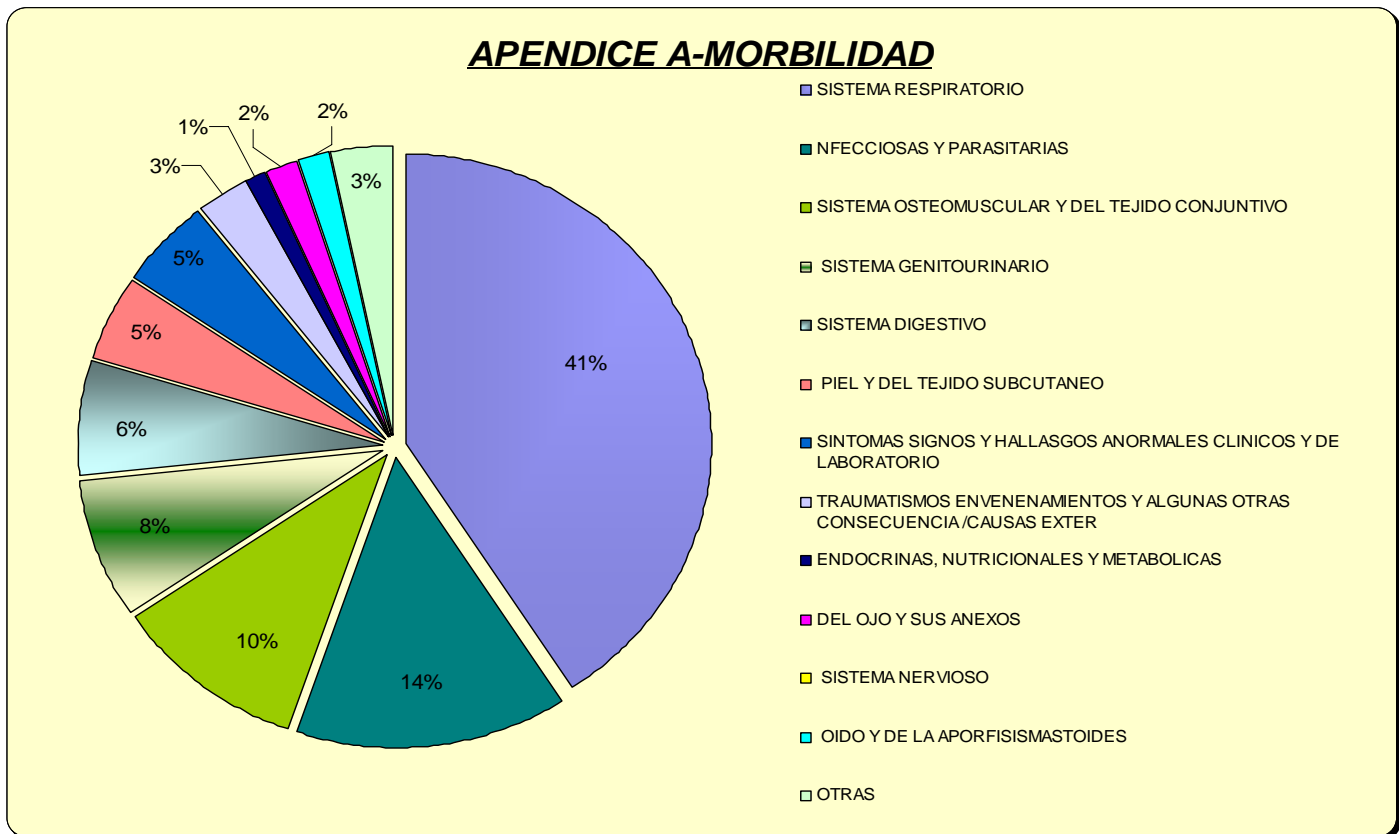

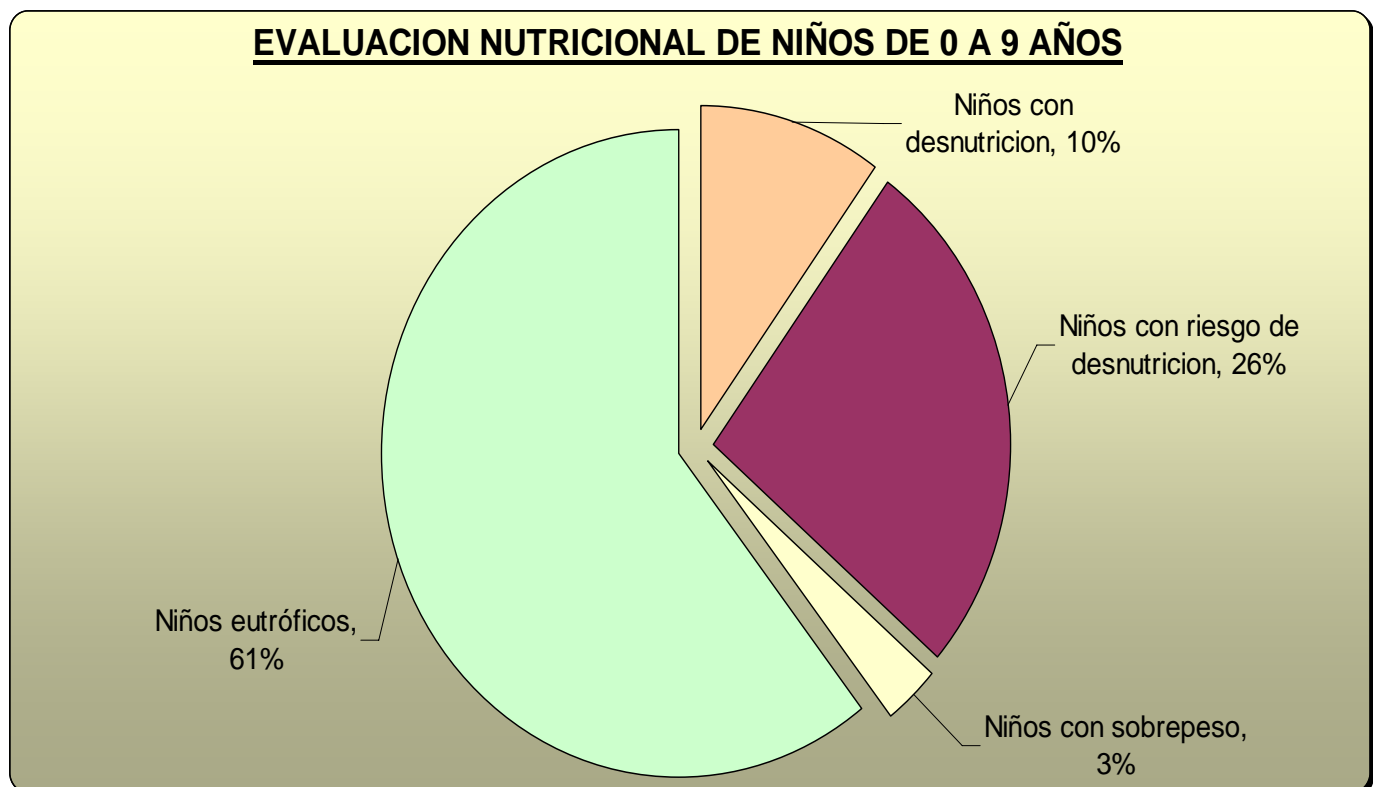
