

RMF constructs pre-school building for Dickwella children

Dr. Martinac Fuchs, Executive Director of Real Medical Foundation (RMF) built, donated and ceremonially declared open the Minhath pre-school of Yonakapura, Dickwella for the Muslim pre-school children, a crying need for them in the area.

Mrs. Stephany Minerva Fernando, the project coordinator of RMF, addressing the gathering at the one-day Health Clinic had said there was an urgent need for a building for Yonakapura pre-school children to accommodate their classes.

RMF had volunteered to pay the salaries of 5 teachers serving at Tangalla children's pre-school and also the salaries of 3 teachers of Minhath pre-school at Dickwella.

RMF helped six children suffering from retardation of growth by providing hormone injections at a cost of Rs. 130,000 a month, she said.

Mrs. Upamali Munaweera of Los Angeles, California, USA who represented Dr. Martinac Fuchs, stated that she was highly satisfied when she browsed the Website of the RMF services rendered in Tangalla.

She said she came to participate in this Health Clinic at Dickwella and she would further help the organisation by raising funds from Los Angeles donors, where she had citizenship.

Dr. G. G. Chamal Sanjeewa, the Medical Consultant of the RMF examined and treated 148 patients of varying ages from infants to adults.
